Accommodation

The negotiated accommodation charges of £90.00 (plus £15.00 for single occupancy) per double room per night, inclusive of VAT and full English breakfast, represents very good value for the area for superb facilities & services; a single room is £80.00 per night.

This Hotel is very popular and has put aside a quantity of rooms for anticipated use by us, It is strongly recommended that you should book your accommodation (**quoting 95th Reunion**), as soon as possible. There is a deposit of £50.00 required per booking.

It is anticipated that some of you will choose to stay 3 nights (15th, 16th & 17th June); others may choose to stay 2 nights and some just 1 night. This flexibility is included in the negotiated rate.

Reunion Dinner

The reunion dinner on Thursday 16th will be taken in a private function room and will be your choice from a Reunion Menu (to be defined) comprising 4 Starters; 4 Mains and 4 sweet and will be charged at £30.00 per head, which is a very reasonable cost.

The selected menu will be forwarded in due course when you will be asked to make your choices.

You will be reminded of your choices on the night, in a manner similar to previous occasions.

Hotel Information

Formerly a farmhouse, Barnsdale Lodge was converted in 1989 and is positioned on the North shore of Rutland Water in the heart of the beautiful, unspoilt, county of Rutland, just a few minutes from the historic towns of Oakham, Oundle, Uppingham and Stamford.

Barnsdale Lodge Hotel has forty-five bedrooms, all non smoking, all en-suite and individually furnished with charm and style. The hotel has double, twin, single and family rooms with broadband connection, direct dial telephone, digital free-view, a selection of teas and coffee and biscuits, hairdryer and steam iron. Guests can enjoy a range of complimentary White Company toiletries in the bathrooms.

A number of bedrooms have been designed to take into consideration those with disabilities. These rooms are all on the ground floor with easy access, walk-in showers and handrails.

Guests at Barnsdale Lodge Hotel can expect the very best food, wine and personal service in the conservatory, theatre, cottage room, main dining room, one of the function suites or alfresco dining in the courtyard.

Their kitchen uses locally sourced, seasonal produce. Local Suppliers include Manton Farm, for asparagus, raspberries and strawberries and Grasmere Farm for pork. They source their game from Easton Estate, approximately 12 miles from the hotel and have a kitchen garden in the hotel grounds, growing vegetables and herbs which are used on many of the dishes in the restaurant. Their own rare-breed hens also provide beautiful fresh eggs. I can hear cries of "So what!" but the thing is - "they care enough to do it". That has to count for something.

Barnsdale Lodge's restaurant is open to residents and non residents for breakfast, morning coffee, lunch, afternoon tea and dinner and is renowned for its private dining.
